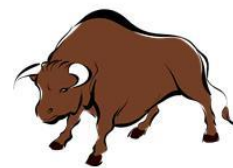


### The Arena:

## A.R.S.S. SHOW REGULATIONS & CONDITIONS

### Site holders- Exhibitors, Stall, Food

All stall holders must pay the normal admission fee.

Written applications for sites must be lodged, with full payment to the Secretary by close **COB Friday 3rd June 2011.**

All site holders must comply with the site application regulations and must have paid and filled out correct paperwork prior to commencement of trade.

All site holders must have attached a current copy of their Public Liability Certificate of Currency attached to their applications. Not for Profit organizations need to apply to the A.R.S.S. committee if need to be covered by the A.R.S.S. public Liability.

All food sites must have a current Health Food Permit.

No refunds will be made to site holders unless approved by the committee.

Site holders requiring power will pay by the outlet- multiple power boards are not to be used off one outlet.

The space must be used ONLY for the purpose specified in the original application and by the person/group who applied.

The Show will take place where the Society shall appoint.

Games must be games of skill, not chance, and the decision of the Side Show Steward on the conduct of any sideshow or stall will be final.

Site holders are prohibited from selling, giving away, or using as prizes the following: **water pistols, cap guns, fireworks**, or any other article which could cause annoyance to the public at the Showgrounds.

The use of loudspeakers or amplifiers is prohibited unless approved by the Side Show Steward.

All site holders must comply with Occupation Work Health & Safety regulations or they will be asked to leave.

The Society accepts no responsibility for any accident which may be caused by or through the site holder or happen in connection with their business, and the site holder shall hold the Society blameless.

The Society shall have the right to remove from the Show grounds, at any time, any sideshow and/or person connected with it, who is in the opinion of the Society /executive, objectionable or may be detrimental to the Society's interests, and no person so removed shall have the right of action or claim for damages, costs, expenses, or otherwise against the Society in respect of any action taken by the Society under the regulations.

All sideshow operators shall remain within their frontage and not work beyond six feet of that frontage.

All charges for sideshow space must be paid in full before **COB Friday 3rd June 2011.** Early bird paid applications will receive 2 free adult passes. The Committee placement of sites is final.

Should the Committee have any reason to suspect that any exhibit is diseased or dangerous, they reserve the right to refuse admission to the Showground or to remove the same from the ground at the expense of the exhibitor.

The Society reserves the right to cancel or postpone the show or any part thereof for any sufficient cause.

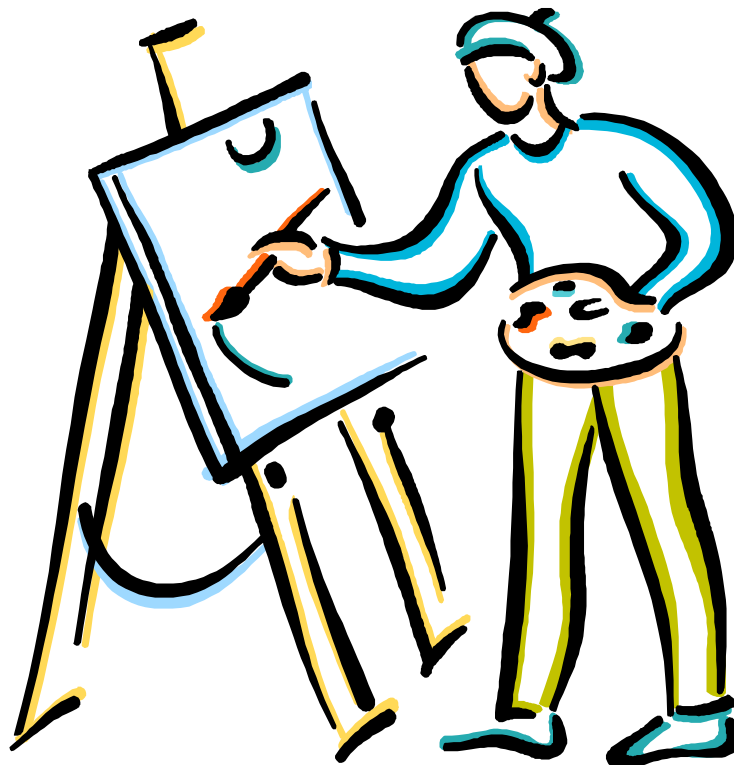

### **Lead-Line Tiny Tots:**

Any AQHA legal style of bit is permitted and all competitors are to use two hands on the reins when riding either a Junior or Senior horse in this class. Competitors 18yrs and under must wear an approved ASA helmet in all ridden events. AQHA rules/regulations apply to all other equipment to be used. All competitors must be suitably attired in Western Wear.

### **Beginner 15yrs/over:**

Beginner refers to the rider not the horse. Open to competitors 15yrs and over as of August 1<sup>st</sup> annually, who have not gained more than 10 (ten) AQHA points at any AQHA approved show. Any AQHA legal style of bit is permitted and all competitors are to use two hands on the reins when riding either a Junior or Senior horse in this class. Competitors 18yrs and under must wear an approved ASA helmet in all ridden events. AQHA rules/regulations apply to all other equipment to be used. All competitors must be suitably attired in Western Wear.

### **Beginner All Age:**

Beginner refers to the rider not the horse. Open to all Beginner riders who have not gained more than 10 (ten) AQHA points at any AQHA approved show. Any AQHA legal style of bit is permitted and all competitors are to use two hands on the reins when riding either a Junior or Senior horse in this class. Competitors 18yrs and under must wear an approved ASA helmet in all ridden events. AQHA rules/regulations apply to all other equipment to be used. All competitors must be suitably attired in Western Wear.

### **Youth:**

Open to competitors 18yrs and under as of August 1<sup>st</sup> annually. Approved ASA helmets are to be worn by competitors in ridden events. AQHA rules/regulations apply regarding the age of horse ridden and equipment to be used. Competitors must be suitably attired in Western Wear.

### **Seniors:**

Open to competitors aged between 19 yrs and 39 yrs as of August 1<sup>st</sup> annually. All Junior & Senior horses in this class must be ridden according to AQHA rules/regulations for the age of the horse and equipment to be used. All competitors must be suitably attired in Western Wear.

### **Masters:**

Open to competitors aged 40years and over as of August 1<sup>st</sup> annually. All Junior & Senior horses in this class must be ridden according to AQHA rules/regulations for the age of the horse and equipment to be used. All competitors must be suitably attired in Western Wear.

### **Junior Horse:**

Open to horses aged between 2yrs and 5yrs as of August 1<sup>st</sup> annually. To be ridden in a snaffle bit with two hands or a curb bit and chain with one hand. AQHA rules/regulations apply regarding the choice of this and all other equipment to be used. All competitors must be suitably attired in Western Wear.

### **Senior Horse:**

Open to horses aged 6yrs and over as of August 1<sup>st</sup> annually. To be ridden in any legal style of curb bit and chain with one hand. AQHA rules/regulations apply to this and all other equipment to be used. All competitors must be suitably attired in Western Wear.

### **Halter:**

All horses must wear a suitable leather halter with chain & lead, for all Halter events including Showmanship At Halter. Only registered Quarter Horses are eligible to compete in Quarter Horse Halter Classes. A copy of all Quarter Horses registration papers must be lodged with the nomination form.

### **Pattern Events:**

For all Pattern Events such as, *Showmanship At Halter/Western Horsemanship/Trail*, the patterns for these events will be posted in a prominent viewing place on the day. You will need a note book and pen to copy your patterns.
