



## A.R.S.S. SHOW REGULATIONS & CONDITIONS

### Site holders-Exhibitors, Stall, Food

1. All stall holders must pay the normal admission fee, unless otherwise stated on application.
2. Written applications for sites must be lodged, with full payment to the Secretary by close **COB Friday 1st June 2012**.
3. All site holders must comply with the site application regulations and must have paid and filled out correct paperwork prior to commencement of trade.
4. All site holders must have attached a current copy of their Public Liability Certificate of Currency attached to their applications. Not for Profit organizations need to apply to the A.R.S.S. committee if need to be covered by the A.R.S.S. public Liability.
5. All food sites must have a current Health Food Permit.
6. No refunds will be made to site holders unless approved by the committee.
7. Site holders requiring power will pay by the outlet- multiple power boards are not to be used off one outlet.
8. The space must be used **ONLY** for the purpose specified in the original application and by the person/group who applied.
9. The Show will take place where the Society shall appoint.
10. Games must be games of skill, not chance, and the decision of the Side Show Steward on the conduct of any sideshow or stall will be final.
11. Site holders are prohibited from selling, giving away, or using as prizes the following: **water pistols, cap guns, fireworks**, or any other article which could cause annoyance to the public at the Showgrounds.
12. The use of loudspeakers or amplifiers is prohibited unless approved by the Side Show Steward.
13. All site holders must comply with Occupation Work Health & Safety regulations or they will be asked to leave.
14. The Society accepts no responsibility for any accident which may be caused by or through the site holder or happen in connection with their business, and the site holder shall hold the Society blameless.
15. The Society shall have the right to remove from the Show grounds, at any time, any sideshow and/or person connected with it, who is in the opinion of the Society /executive, objectionable or may be detrimental to the Society's interests, and no person so removed shall have the right of action or claim for damages, costs, expenses, or otherwise against the Society in respect of any action taken by the Society under the regulations.
16. All sideshow operators shall remain within their frontage and not work beyond six feet of that frontage.
17. All charges for sideshow space must be paid in full before **COB Friday 1st June 2012**. Early bird paid applications will receive 2 free adult passes. The Committee placement of sites is final.
18. Should the Committee have any reason to suspect that any exhibit is diseased or dangerous, they reserve the right to refuse admission to the Showground or to remove the same from the ground at the expense of the exhibitor.
19. The Society reserves the right to cancel or postpone the show or any part thereof for any sufficient cause.
20. No Alcohol to be brought to the Showground. Alcohol may only be purchased and consumed in the Bar areas.

## **IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS**

Any Exhibitors intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showground will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with **EARTH LEAKAGE CIRCUIT BREAKERS** and that all Electrical Leads, tools and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor.

### **All Electrical Leads must be off the ground.**

This is essential for the safety of yourself, your fellow exhibitors and the general public and is a requirement of the Occupation Health and Safety Act of 2000.

The Act imposes very severe penalties in the event of non-compliance with its provisions.

Any Exhibitors who do not comply will not be allowed to exhibit at the Showground.

Please check all your electrical equipment and leads before you come to the Showground to avoid the occurrence of any difficulties.

### **Accident & Public Risk**

Any accident occurring during the Annual Show, or other function held by the Society, must be reported to the Secretary's office, AND VERIFIED during the current dates of the Show or other function, otherwise the Society will accept no responsibility for the consideration of any claim.

The Society will not be responsible for any accident that may be caused through or by any exhibitor or competitor, or as a result of any act of neglect of any Steward or member of the Committee or public, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Society harmless, and indemnify it against any legal proceedings arising from any such accident, and to agree to all the rules.

**DAMAGE TO EXHIBITS :** the Society will not, under any circumstances, hold itself responsible for any loss or misdelivery of livestock or other exhibits at the Society's Exhibition, or for any damage thereto or loss thereof.

**LOSS BY DISEASE:** the signing of the certificate of entry of any animal will be taken as a guarantee that the animal specified is free from all disease being spread through or by any exhibit, and the Exhibitor shall be held responsible.

**Exhibitors ARE NOT entitled to free admission.**
